John Mezydlo's deacon ordination is scheduled for Sept. 6, at 10:00 a.m. at St. John the Evangelist Cathedral in Milwaukee. FEAST OF THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

This feast is celebrated on Friday, August 15, and is a **Holy Day of Obligation**. **Two Masses** will be celebrated at St. Bruno's: a *Mass of Anticipation* on Thursday evening at 7:00 p.m. and the other on Friday morning at 9:00 a.m. **Two Holyday Masses** will be celebrated at St. Paul's: one on Friday morning at 9:00 a.m. and the other on Friday night at 7:00 p.m.

Did you know that the ***Feast of the Assumption*** is considered the *principal* feast of the Blessed Virgin Mary! It is the celebration of the “departure of Mary from this life and her bodily assumption into heaven”. We don't know the day, year or manner of Mary's death, but tradition has said that she was assumed from either Jerusalem or Ephesus anywhere from 3-15 years after Jesus' death. The belief in Mary's bodily assumption was not universally **celebrated** in the East and West until the ninth or tenth century, but in 1950, Pope Pius XII dogmatically and infallibly defined the Assumption of Mary a *doctrine of faith* “that once Mary completed her life on earth she was assumed body and soul into heaven”. The Church has never answered the question of whether Mary died before or after rising to heaven.
