THAT MAN IS YOU / BE A MAN!!!



Both St. Paul and St. Bruno Parishes have been sponsoring something that I think is phenomenal. **It is an early morning program once a week for thirteen weeks with a commitment of about an hour per week. It is uniquely for MEN.** It is the première Catholic men's program sweeping the country. Over the years I have observed men interacting with their families and with other adults. So often, that interaction revolves around superficiality, *with little attention focused on the man's or others' faith life.* **"That Man Is You/Be A Man"** is a dynamic, interactive multimedia program that focuses on authentic male leadership and transforms the faith lives of men, inspiring them to live their faith more explicitly. It helps make men better husbands and better fathers along with deepening their friendship with God. The program inspires men to internalize their Catholic faith and then live it more visibly.

In this 5th year of the program at St. Bruno, Fr.
