BLESSING OF THROATS

We know that *Bishop Blaise* was martyred in his Episcopal city of Sebastea, Armenia, in 316. The legendary Acts of St. Blaise were written 400 years later. According to them, Blaise was a good bishop, working hard to encourage the spiritual and physical health of his people. Legend has it, a mother came with her young son who had a fish bone lodged in his throat. At Blaise's command the child was able to cough up the bone. Because Blaise's blessing saved the boy from choking on the fish bone, it has become a custom that people have their throats blessed on his feast and through his intercession. **The annual Blessing of Throats will take place at the end of the 8:00 a.m. Mass on Tuesday, February 3, the Feast of St. Blaise.**

PROGRAMMABLE THERMOSTATS**

When: Year-round.

Why bother: The average household spends more than \$2,000 a year on energy bills - nearly half of which goes to heating and cooling. You can save as much as **10% a year** on heating and cooling by simply turning your thermostat back 7°-10°F for eight hours a day from its normal setting.

What you can do: Using a programmable thermostat allows you to use less energy without sacrificing comfort. Once installed, programmable thermostats can store multiple daily settings (six or more temperature settings a day) that you can manually override without affecting the rest of the daily or weekly program.
