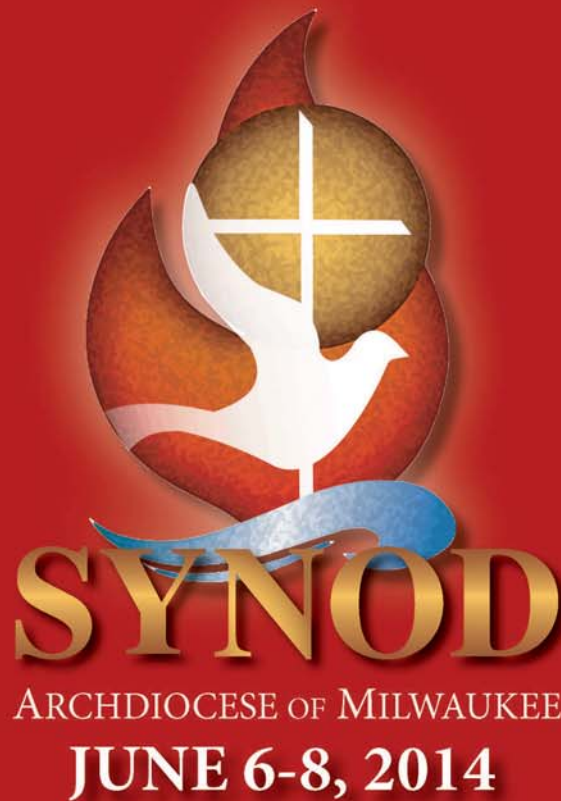

SYNOD 2014 – A NEW PENTECOST



This is it! **John Mezydlo, Jr., and I** are participating as St. Bruno's Delegates at the *Archdiocesan Synod* that is happening this weekend, June 7/8. There are approximately 500 delegates from around the Archdiocese gathered at the Archbishop Cousins Catholic Center in the city of St. Francis. During the Synod, we Delegates will be discussing eight main "Mission Areas". In each "Mission Area", six to ten "Key Initiative Summaries" have come forth from the District Synod Sessions that were held last February. After listening to two major addresses by Archbishop ListECKi and Bishop Hying, and sharing in small group discussions and small-group and large-group discernment, **detailed future "initiatives" will be voted on by the Delegates.** These "initiatives" will give direction to our Archdiocese for the next 10-15 years. ***We Delegates will be instruments of the Holy Spirit! Please pray for that Spirit's work among us and within us!***
