ASSOCIATE PASTOR'S PEN A MESSAGE FROM FR. CHUCK WROBEL



So, I was asked to write an article to introduce myself to the communities of St. Bruno and St. Paul. I have done this several times in the past – through speeches or articles for newsletters – but it's kinda difficult to fit 48 years into three paragraphs. So, here we go with just the basics.

I was born in Green Bay back in 1966, into an amazing family (the second of five children). We moved to Ripon when I was about three years old. We lived there until I was going into 6th grade. While in Ripon, I attended the Parish School at St. Patrick Parish from 1st to 5th grade. We moved to Arkansas, where I eventually graduated from high school, and then attended St. Norbert College where I graduated with a Bachelor Degree in Art. I was not moved to continue with this degree, and through different circumstances I found out about Physical Therapy and ended up pursuing that. I earned a Bachelor Degree in Physical Therapy from the University of Central Arkansas.

My first real job after graduation was as a Physical Therapist at the Arkansas Children's Hospital where I worked for two and a half years. I then went on to do contract work, working in different locations for about

three months at a time. I did that for about three years and then finally settled down in Sheboygan at St. Nicholas Hospital. There, I worked full-time for six years and part-time/casual for another six years while attending seminary.

My road to the seminary and priesthood is an entirely other article or chapter in a book. If you would like to read more, there was a nice article published in the *Catholic Herald* before I was ordained (<http://chnonline.org/news/local-news/9474-long-path-strong-commitment-to-priesthood>).

I have been a priest for four years. My first assignment was at Holy Apostles Catholic Parish in New Berlin, where I served as Associate Pastor for three years. I was then appointed Administrator of St. Matthew and Shepherd of the Hills Parishes in Campbellsport and Eden for the past year.

I am very happy to return to this area to serve the people of Genesee Depot and Dousman, and the vast areas around here.

SYNOD VOTING RESULTS & OUTCOMES

Thousands of Catholics, over the course of the past eighteen months, studied, discussed and discerned the needs of the local Catholic Church. On June 7-8, led by the Holy Spirit, approximately 500 delegates and representatives from parishes and other Catholic organizations from across the Archdiocese met to discern those needs and vote on what they felt were the highest priorities. The voting results and outcomes of the Synod are outlined and available on the Archdiocesan website at: <http://www.archmil.org/Synod2014/Results.htm>.

In September, Archbishop Listecki will release a *Synodal Declaration* based on the outcomes of the work of the past year and a half, as well as on the fruits of the Synod assembly. The Declaration will outline his pastoral priorities for the Catholic Church in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee and will guide our work as a Church for the next decade and beyond.
