It was a great occasion to get together to dust off my old (literally old) clubs; enjoy the exquisite weather and beautiful golf course; meet, fellowship, and get to know some of the people who attended; eat wonderful food and above all support the education of the children of the Parish.

A week before that I went to a workshop at Notre Dame for school pastors. I don't know yet how earth-shattering the workshop was, but one of the things that they spoke about was the need to see the School as another ministry of the Parish. So oftentimes it seems that it becomes a separate entity and even a drain, rather than an integral part of the church community.

The ministries we have for our children need to be guarded and fostered. We should do everything we can to encourage our children in their/our faith. It is through these ministries that we teach them service to the church, to the community, and to each other. It is through these ministries that we teach them about how to develop relationships with each other, with family, and especially with God (which ultimately is reflected in all other relationships).

As I understand and have heard, there have been some problems in the schools. I don't know those details, and probably don't want to know them, but I am really sorry

to hear that things have happened to the detriment of our children.

That being said, I am very excited about the opportunities we have ahead of us as a Parish (St. Bruno or St. Paul) to step up and make this an amazing community. I love being with the children. I love learning from the children. I love seeing God reflected in their eyes, their words, and their actions. I am also looking forward to working with the two amazing principals that are present, as well as the team of teachers that have invested themselves in the Catholic and academic education of our children.

I have had A LOT of Catholic education in my life and would not be the person I am was it not for that. I ask that you pray for and support our Catholic schools and if you know someone who would benefit from attending the School (Catholic or not), invite them to come. (If money is an issue, please speak to the Principal or Pastor(s) about that.)

Most importantly, in whatever you do, love the children, teach them about God, encourage them and serve with them, and let them know that God loves them unconditionally by the way you love them yourself.

Why Prayer Ministry?

We are simply doing as Jesus did! In Luke 4:40, at the start of Jesus' ministry, we are told that: "When the sun was setting, the people brought to Jesus all who had various kinds of sickness, and laying His hands on each one, He healed them". In Mark 6:5, we read how Jesus visited His hometown of Nazareth, but encountered such a lack of faith that "He could not do any miracles there, except lay His hands on a few sick people and heal them". In Matthew 19:13, we are told that "little children were brought to Jesus for Him to place His hands on them and pray for them". Jesus clearly saw the laying on of hands as an important way to pray with people.
