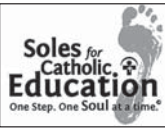

CHRISTMAS CHOIR RETREAT



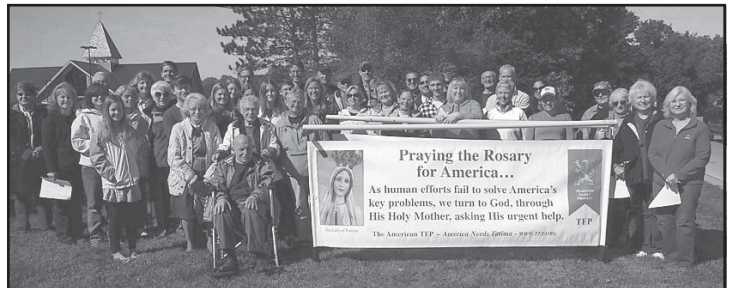
