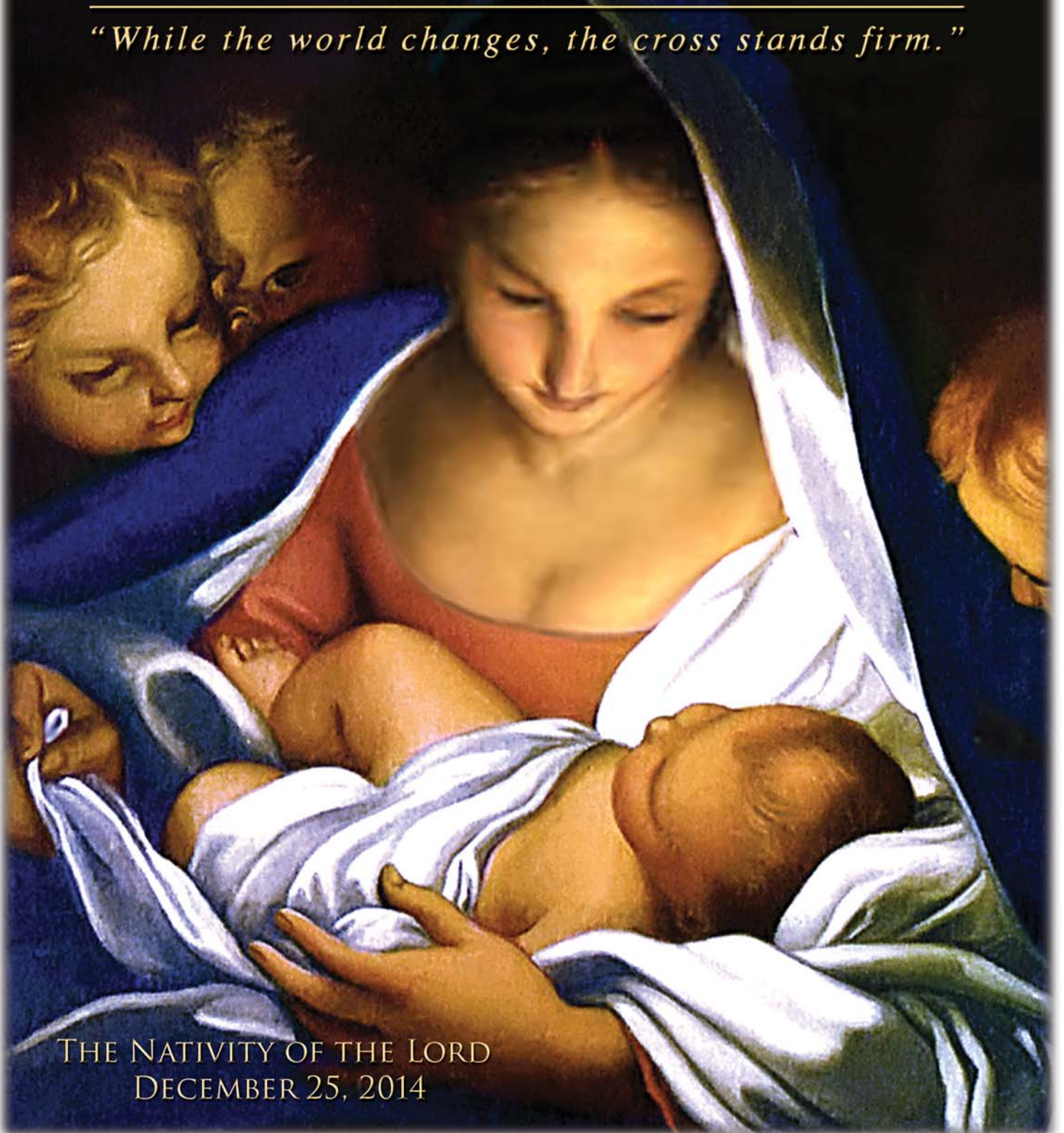

CHRISTMAS IS INCARNATION – “THE WORD BECAME FLESH”



God chose to become flesh. For a thousand years before Jesus' birth the prophets proclaimed the coming of a Messiah. Their words were really the Word (of God). That Word became flesh and actually “dwelt among us”. God no longer was *simply* the God of creation, the creator of the earth, sky, sea, sunrise, animals and people. He became *more* than the author of the Ten Commandments, the Pillar of Fire, the Wind that split the Red Sea, and the Ark of the Covenant. **God Himself became flesh in the world.** He was incarnated. HELP SANTA E-CYCLE**

Why bother: State law forbids land-filling many kinds of electronics; they contain components that are hazardous to soil, air and living things. Valuable components can be "mined" and used in new electronics.

What you can do: Sometimes the seller will take the old item. If not, Goodwill Retail stores, Best Buy, Radke Appliance, some municipalities, and others will take some items. Phone prior to taking items for disposal.
