## NATIONAL MIGRATION WEEK 2015: JAN. 4-10

### WE ARE ONE FAMILY UNDER GOD



National Migration Week 2015 will take place **January 4-10** with the theme, "We are One Family Under God", which brings to mind the importance of family in our daily lives. This reminder is particularly important when dealing with the migration phenomenon, as family members are too often separated from one another. Following is a prayer highlighting the Holy Family, reminding us of the important role that family plays in our lives and the precarious existence of families who are caught in a migration experience. If nothing else, I would hope that it gives us an appreciation for the families that we have in our lives.

*Loving Father,*

*Remembering that the Holy Family fled violence and lived for a time as refugees, we ask that you protect all refugee families fleeing persecution, and provide them a place of safety and comfort.*

*For children who are making perilous journeys, often alone and without protection of loved ones, we ask that you reunite them with their families and protect them from violence on the journey.*

*For all migrants, that they not feel compelled to migrate but have opportunities in their homeland where they can thrive and live fully human lives.*

*Open our hearts so that we may provide hospitality for those who come in search of refuge, through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who live ad reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, forever and ever. Amen*

As important as it is that we pray for just immigration laws and the general belief that ALL people should be treated with a real dignity that is bestowed on us by God, I think that we can look in our own back yard to help people in need as they migrate from place to place. We should be able to extend a hand of welcome to people who move to our neighborhood, introduce ourselves to people who are new at church or work or school, and rather than looking funny at people because they are new we should help them feel at home in the new community in which they now live and hope to belong.

### SUMMER YOUTH OPPORTUNITIES

It's not too early to start planning summer programs. The teens of St. Bruno and St. Paul Parishes have three great opportunities to grow in their faith and awareness of social justice during the month of July 2015.

**Catholic Heart Work Camp – July 5-11:** This is a traditional “Mission Trip”. Students will travel by van to Fremont, Nebraska, and stay at a school. Each day starts with Mass, then students will work with an agency doing home repairs for the elderly and helping out at shelters, food banks and daycare sites. Evenings will be filled with activities, music, skits, videos, group sharing time, speakers and prayer. Spaces are VERY limited—so please reserve your spot today!

**Reach Out Reach In – July 12-17: RORI** is a Mission Trip that takes place right in the Milwaukee Archdiocese. Students stay at St. Monica's in Whitefish Bay and are divided into work groups that have a variety of sites in the Metro Milwaukee area, as well as some farms in Ozaukee County.

**Steubenville Youth Conference – July 24-26:** This conference is held at the University of St. Thomas in St. Paul, MN. Students will travel by coach bus to a weekend conference which provides outstanding Catholic speakers, workshops, daily Mass and reconciliation.

St. Bruno's will be collaborating with St. Paul's on the Catholic Heart and Steubenville trips. *Reach Out Reach In* is a program that you can attend on your own (or better yet, ask some friends to join you!). There are fees with each of the trips, but students may participate in fundraising to help keep their costs affordable.
