C. Transition Initiative Report – Feedback on November 9 meeting

The question was raised and a discussion went on as to why the decision about the organizational structure of the parishes didn't involve the input of the Pastoral Councils. It was noted that creating organizational structure is not within the scope of a Pastoral Council's responsibilities. The Council is a policy-formulating body that clarifies the parish's vision, establishes goals and witnesses the gospel message. Administrative decisions relating to staff and structure are the responsibility of the pastors. In this case the pastors felt that matching structures were needed for the two parishes. After making that decision and formulating a new organizational structure the pastors' first move was to call the November 9 meeting to inform the two Pastoral Councils.

D. Pastor's Report

A district meeting to follow up on the Synod will be held on February 12 from 6:30-9:00 at St. Anthony's on the Lake. Each parish can send 8 delegates. Fr. Ralph, John Mezydlo, Jr, and Paul Hoffmann will be going. Five more parish leaders from staff, council, or committees (especially Liturgy, Formation, Human Concerns, and Stewardship) will be selected. Father is looking for volunteers to attend this meeting.

E. Ministry Reports

- **-APC** Paul –There was a discussion on the selection process of parish reps. One parish's difficulties highlight the importance of having a transition process.
- -Christian Formation Amanda -No report.
- -Communications Lynn –The committee plans to collect email addresses from parishioners in January. They were hoping to upgrade/improve the website, but will need to develop a new website with a new vendor. Fr. Chuck recommends that our Communications Committee talk to St. Paul's because they are also changing websites.
- **-Human Concerns** Lynn for Carol Thanksgiving Food Drive is going on. The Giving Tree is from Nov. 29 to Dec. 14.

- **-Prayer & Worship –** Louise Minutes were sent to all PC members.
- **-School** John Plans for a school garden location and cost are being considered. Soles for Education was a success. Accreditation is going on.
- -Stewardship Jerry Heather Mezydlo joined the committee. Last week we registered two new parishioners. Upcoming events include a Chili Dump, Men Who Cook (April 18), and an Easter Egg Hunt
- -Buildings & Grounds Pat- The old church has a new roof. Two projects have been postponed due to the early winter weather (parking lot & siding).
- **-Finance Council**—Brian The bike-a-thon as a fund-raiser and community builder is now on the back burner. The Budget Committee is forming.

Mentoring Ministry– Lynn - Betty Igl has been assigning established parishioners as mentors to new parishioners. They will be asking parishioners to sign up to be a mentor in December during Welcome Weekend activities.
