- Mass begins in the Gathering Place with the Blessing of the palms, Reading, a short homily and the procession into the church singing "All Glory, Laud and Honor"
- Need three readers (narrator, voice, crowd) will use the old red hymnals for the Passion Play. Readers must be at church 40 minutes early to dress and practice.
- Need four servers per Mass, usual number of Eucharistic Ministers (8 total)
- Would like to have the liturgical movement after the 10:30 Mass where they
  youth carry symbolic gifts to the altar as done in the past. Cheryl will contact
  Sarah, the youth minister. Kathy will look into acquiring the CD that Mark
  used to play.

### Holy Thursday - Mass @ 7pm

- Deb will coordinate with Sue & Mary helping
- Sacristan Deb or Mary
- Need three servers, usual number of Eucharistic Ministers (have two deacons)
- Passover Story by family Cheryl will contact Tammy Price for suggestions
- Bells (for Gloria) Sue will put reminder in the bulletin to bring bells & rice bowls
- Washing of the feet need 12 people & an extra Sue will find people
- Holy Oils (Sick, Catechumens, Holy Chrism) need three people to bring up to altar (someone who has been anointed, RCIA candidate, Confirmation candidate). Cheryl will contact Mary Kral about the RCIA candidate and Sarah about a Confirmation candidate. Fr. Ralph will find someone who has been anointed.
- Will have a blessing at the end of Mass for Eucharistic Ministers and a Eucharistic Procession, which will include the First Communicants and their families, and the Eucharistic Ministers.
- Deb will contact Amy Golden regarding the involvement of the First Communicants.
- Music for Procession: After the procession, the Blessed Sacrament is taken
  into the chapel and it is incensed in the chapel. Once in the chapel, Mark
  would switch to another piece of music. When the music is finished, priest &
  deacon come out of the chapel. In silence, the deacon and servers strip the
  altar. The congregation leaves in silence.

- Need sacristan, three servers, readers for "crowd" part (deacons will also be readers) & four Eucharistic Ministers total
- Will need to get the big cross out.
- Will post a sign-up for four cross bearers. (Sue & Jan)
