Wednesday, August 16 @6:00 pm

Paul K will bring his Farmall tractor and chains to remove the barberry bushes in front of the Ottawa Ave School entrance. Several other small trees need to be pulled also. Doug, Mike and Mary will be there for sure. The weed infested flower bed under the crabapple tree in front of the school garden will be cleaned up and or out.

We will need to straighten the area with more dirt and plant grass seed. Mary will contact Lawe to see if they have topsoil. We need to add topsoil to the west side of the rectory also. Possible plastic flower pots that look like clay pots that match the 4 pots already in place at the chapel and church entrance. Will contact Dave Strobel for flowers. If placed away from the roof line, Mother Nature will help water them. :)

Korean Spice bushes by the entrance of the former church need pruning as do the forsythia in front of the bell tower and the boiler room and the yews in front the church.

Three outside light fixtures need attention and or repair. Kurt will handle that and get an electrician if necessary.

Mike C will work on painting the under hang of the former church entrance, he will match the paint from chips taken off the boards. Mike will also work on putting a finish on the picnic tables that did not get done last year.

Doug Becker will reseal the outside of the chapel door if we can determine what the door is made of. Steve will look in the records for information on the door and Mary will contact PRA, John J. Holz, the firm who designed the church and helped with the replacement door.

Thank you Mike and Paul, our weed sprayers.

Steve Spiegelhoff presented a proposal for a screen in the gathering place. There is some confusion as to where it might be placed, Steve said the corner by the kitchen and cloak room and Bill Snyder suggest the corner by the windows and the Parish meeting room. Steve presented possible uses and a cost sheet.

What is being done about the current system in place (already wired) for filming over flow masses at Easter and Christmas.

What kind of wiring will need to be done and have the electrical drawings of the Gathering Place and Church been reviewed.

What happens to presentations that are now done from the altar for special presentations for funds from the Archdiocese.

Sound system.

Who will manage this ?

How will it be secured from the public.

Traffic flow when it is being used, set up needed

Has anyone looked into making the screen system portable, so it can be used thru out the whole campus. Update what we have now, clean out the family room closet and store it there.

Have we gone to other parishes to see how they manage a screen system, the plus and the minus.

More information is needed. Has Tim Dittman , our sound expert been consulted on this ? Tim is the expert because he is the person who wired the church for sound. This is Tim's business.
